THOUGHT: There's no danger of developing eyestrain from looking at the bright side of things!

I was driving to the church building one Sunday morning not long ago. It was a sunny spring day. The sky was deep blue, and the air was crisp following lovely spring rains the day before.

As I drove up a busy four-lane road full of traffic even on a Sunday morning, I noticed that some cars ahead had put on their brake lights and were slowing to a halt.

I soon found out why. A mother duck was crossing the road, and behind her, of course, was her little brood of seven or eight ducklings, all lined up, following her blindly, knowing that Mother Duck would lead them to safety.

I had no idea where this mother duck and her family came from or where they were going. To my knowledge there was neither park nor pond nearby.

But Mother Duck was determined. She waddled in a straight line across the asphalt with her ducklings and made it safely across the two northbound lanes and was headed into the southbound lanes when I saw that a pickup truck had not noticed what was going on.

The Mother Duck continued, and just as she entered the last lane, the driver slowed to a stop. To my consternation, Mother Duck proceeded beneath the truck, between the wheels, with her brood following.

Talk about walking through the valley of the shadow of death! I felt that the Heavenly Father must have been watching out for those ducks that day!

And, don't you know, he watches out for us as well. Who knows when God has been with us when the shadow of adversity has crossed our way? Perhaps we were not even aware of it! It is comforting to know that as we walk through life, we walk and live and breathe in the presence of God. There is no place on earth where we are away from God's abiding love and faithfulness. And yes, my wife and I experienced similar times while serving as missionaries in eastern Europe being following by the KJB on a number of occasions—all totally unknown to us.

Prayer thought:

Loving God, thank you for leading me in the paths of righteousness, for being with me in the valleys and on the mountain tops. Today, I will continue to follow you wherever you lead me. 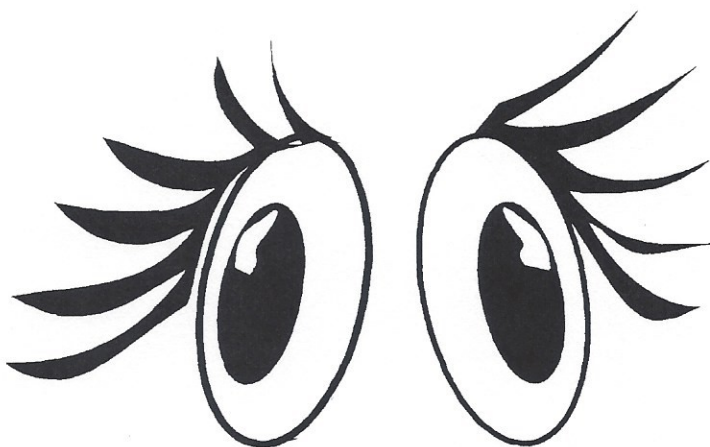
