Scripture Reading: Matthew 2:1-12

THOUGHT: You can do more than pray after you have prayed, but you cannot do
more than pray until you have prayed.John Bunyan

Well, what do you know, one fourth to one third of the year is history! What are going to be the new opportunities and challenges as we continue our journey for the rest of the year? To have a successful trip for the remained of the year, we should plan and prepare for the experiences that lie ahead. Therefore, let's take a look at some of the things we might need in a *"Survival Kit for Life's Daily Experiences."*
