Scripture Reading: I Corinthians 12:1-11

THOUGHT: It's not as important to make a living as it is to make a life. -Hugh Ross

Grandfather picked up the phone to give his 5-year-old granddaughter, Hannah, a call. It had been several days since they had talked. When she got to the phone, she said, "Guess what?"

Grandfather said, "What?"

"I went to art class today!" He was about to ask her what she had drawn in art class when the little girl interrupted and said, "Guess what?"

"What?" he said.

"I learned to jump rope, today!" Grandfather laughed, and was just about to ask how many times she was able to skip rope without stopping when she again interrupted to say, "Guess what?"

"What?"

"We went for a walk to the park today!"

Here was a child for whom life was unfolding so rapidly, that she didn't have time to stop and explain what she'd done in art class, or how well she had skipped rope or what she had seen in the park. Not enough time for that. She needed to share her next "Guess what?"

The child was having "Guess what?" days!

Ever wonder how long it has been since we've had a "Guess what?" day?


