

Instructions are very practical lessons usually beginning with "How To ...". The girls are given hand outs and notebooks filled with useful information to make visits, host a shower, teach Bible class, bring themselves and others closer to God and other practical skills.

The Prayer Walk is a time when the girls are encouraged to take a few minutes with a guided reading. This is when the campers spend time talking and listening to God.

Our Service every day is when we take the girls off campus and expose them to different ways to serve in the church. We have made visits, hosted a ladies' tea, worked in a homeless shelter, hosted a Mothers' Day Out, taught Bible classes, etc.

Every evening, our Fun Activity is exactly that - Fun! We play laser tag, have group game nights, go femaleonly swimming, and have a blast. This is specially designed to give our campers some casual time to grow Christian friendships.

Speak Up! Is a time of discussion where all girls are encouraged to speak. Usually, Speak Up! begins with a question like, "If you could change one things about your life, what would it be?" And other questions that inspire confession, bonding and speaking up.

### CHRISTIAN LEADERSHIP TRAINING

Our counselors are prepared to spend the week immersed in the lives of these girls. They spend their days ENCOURAGING, AFFIRMING, INSPIRING, TEACHING and ENABLING these remarkable campers. We deliberately break down the barriers between campers and staff so the girls feel VALUED and EQUIPPED to take on the next school year with enthusiasm and CONFIDENCE.
